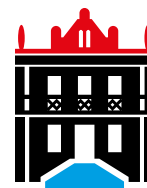

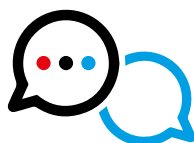

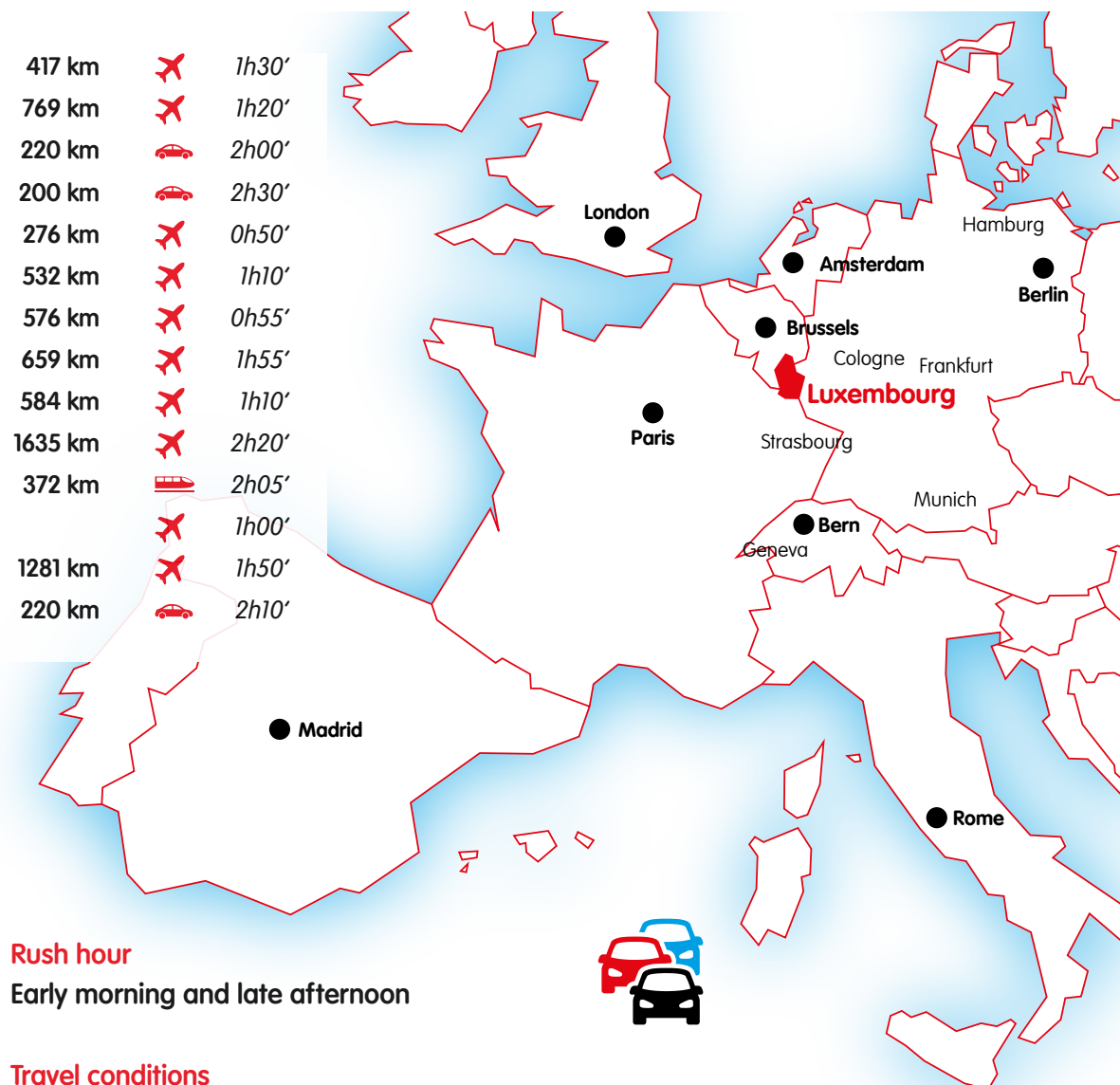

## UNESCO World Heritage:

2019 marked the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Luxembourg City's inscription on the UNESCO World Heritage list in 1994. "Luxembourg, its old quarters and fortifications" bear witness to the city's turbulent history that dates back to the year 963.

## Pétrusse Casemates:

After extensive enhancement and security works, the Pétrusse Casemates reopened to the public in 2022 with a cutting-edge scenography and mesmerising light installations that bring history to life. The origins of this underground military defence systems date back to the 17th century. Explore the Pétrusse Casemates and descend into the capital's rich history!

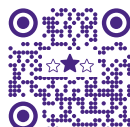

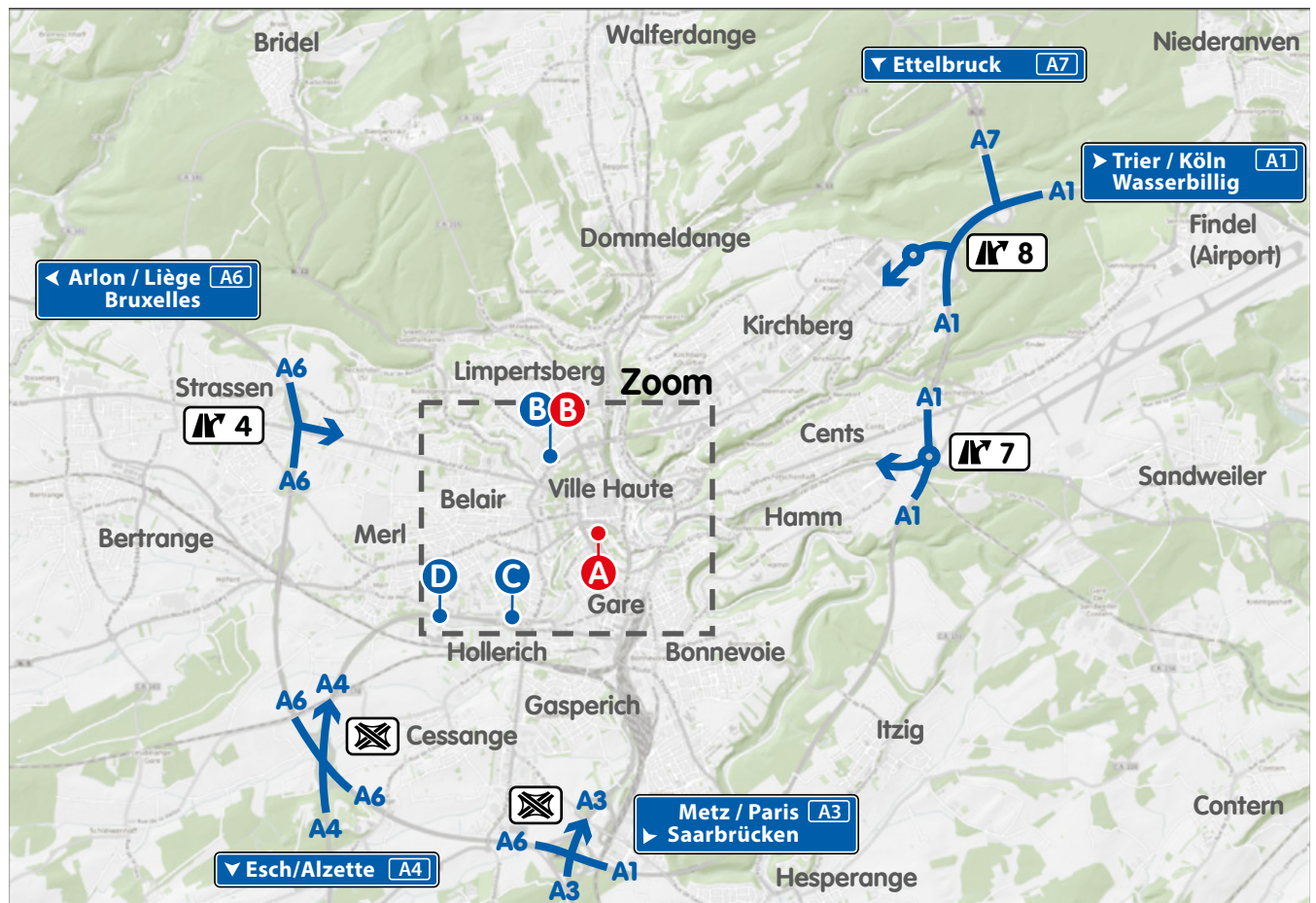

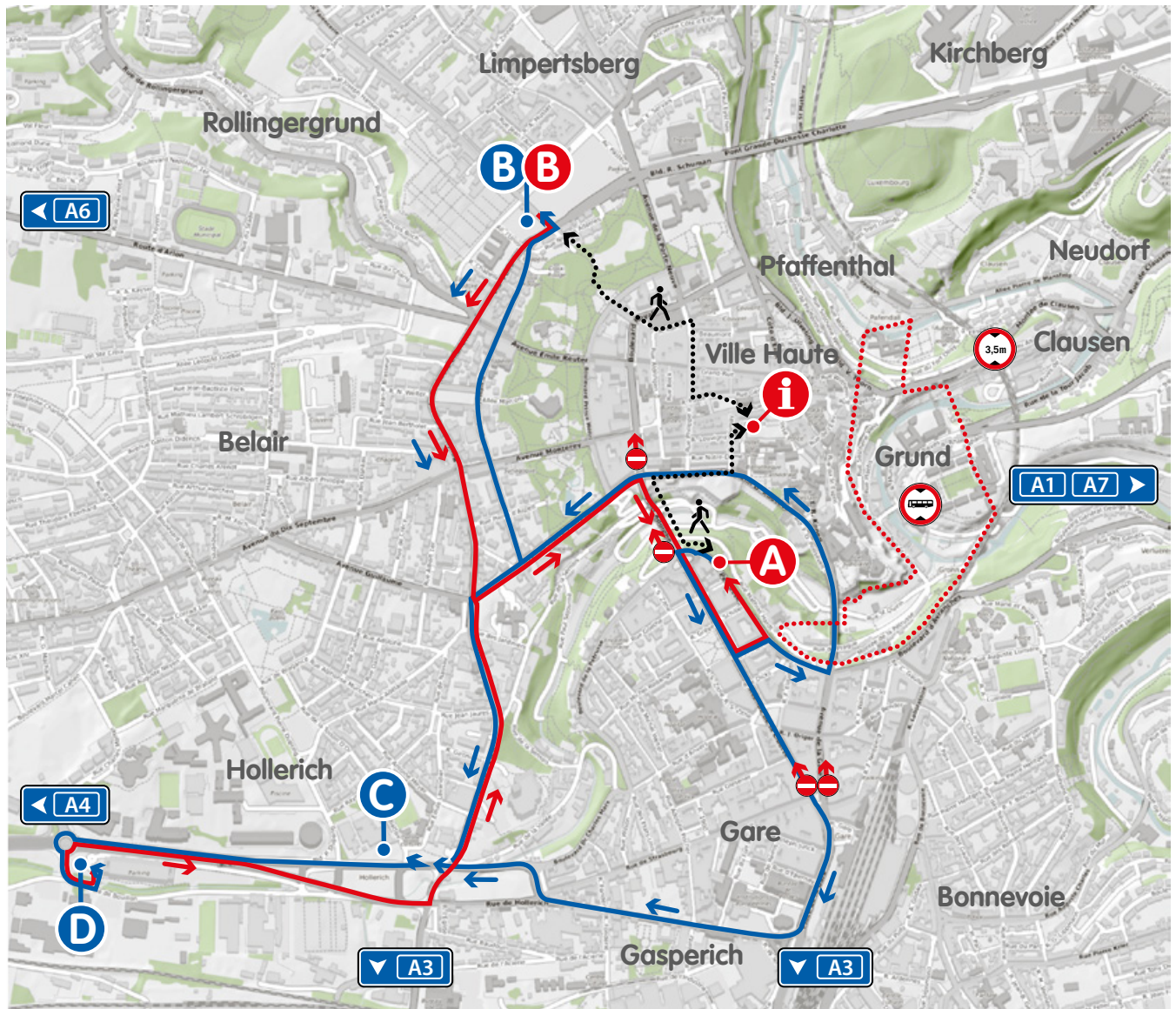
